

2018 STEM Camp Application Information

Due to limited space, admission to Dunwoody's STEM Camp is based on an application process. The competitiveness of admission will be based on the number of applications received and the qualifications of the applicants.

Admission decisions are based on an assessment of each applicant's STEM aptitude and interest. Other factors taken into consideration are participation in extracurricular activities and outstanding talent, achievement, or aptitude as related to STEM. There is no single deciding factor in admission decisions, and students who have strong interest yet little exposure to STEM in school are highly encouraged to apply.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for STEM Camp, students must be:

- In high school, entering their sophomore, junior, or senior year in Fall 2018
- Able to demonstrate interest in STEM careers
- Willing to complete the application and related materials

Application Submission Requirements

The application submission deadline is Friday, May 4, 2018. The following three items must be received by May 4, 2018, in order to be considered for STEM Camp 2018:

1. Completed application form
2. Typed personal statement
3. Letter of recommendation (sent from a high school teacher or counselor; see guidelines below)

Guidelines for Letters of Recommendation

Letters of recommendation should be emailed or mailed directly from a science, technology, engineering, or mathematics teacher or high school counselor. Letters should be one page, printed on school letterhead, and address the applicant's:

- STEM aptitude and interest
- Maturity/personal responsibility
- Motivation/self-reliance

Guidelines for Personal Statement

The student applying to STEM Camp should answer (and type responses to) the following questions:

1. What is the coolest thing you have learned in a science, math, or engineering class? Why do you think this experience was special?
2. In less than 12 bullet points, please list your previous experiences with—and current interest in—science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM).
3. In two-four sentences, please explain what you are hoping to gain from participating in Dunwoody’s STEM Camp.
